School Council – May 10, 2019

**Development/League of Angels**

Caleb Regan reported that the car raffle fell short by \$14,000.00. The Development team is looking at other areas to make up the difference. A golf tournament is being added for next year.

**Financial** – The 2019-2020 budget was approved. Changes were made based on the Finance Council's recommendation. The school asked for a 5% increase in the subsidy, however, the Finance Council approved a 2% increase. Discussion surrounding stewardship vs tuition. Currently what has been pledged in stewardship is not meeting the cost to educate a child. The shortfall is close to \$85,000.00. What is being pledged is between 3% and 5%. What the church receives in stewardship is considerably less than the subsidy given to the school. Brennan Fagen reviewed the current tuition agreement and added legal terms. Brennan Fagen made the motion to accept the tuition agreement as written. The motion was seconded by Riley Scott and the motion was approved unanimously.

**Marketing** – NTR.

**School Uniform Policy** – There will be slight changes to the uniform policy for the 2019-2020 school year. Leggings will be restricted to solid colors only - navy white or opaque.

**Questions on Principal's Report & Financials** – No questions or comments. Mrs. Mattern reported that enrollment numbers are slightly higher than this time last year. Mrs. Mattern spoke about some staff changes, retirements and new hires.

Council Terms: The following people respectfully declined to serve on the council next year – Brendon Christy, Karen Blaser and Kate Pickert. Mrs. Mattern asked for ideas of new people to serve on school council. She asked for others to email her suggestions.
