School Council – September 13, 2019

Present: Mary Mattern, Becky Gibson, Kirsten Wondra, Fr. Mick, Riley Scott, Geri Parscale, Andy Holtz, and Caleb Regan.

2019-2020 Goal Assignments / Update – The council needs to read and review.

2019-2020 Staff and Student Information – Mary Mattern shared a summary of student enrollment by grade-level and that overall, student enrollment is up.

2020-21 Enrollment, all students will pay a flat fee of \$500 for enrollment (removing discount for multiple children) and tuition will raise to \$6500 (which is the current cost of educating a student). All families will continue to sign the agreement at enrollment that they are responsible for tuition, even if they choose to withdraw during the year.

Fr. would like us to survey new parents (4-5) questions. Why did you choose Corpus? Etc. to gather feedback. There was conversation about staffing for the upcoming school year, with an overall desire of the council to start earlier than later.

2020-2021 Uniforms Enrollment – Fr. Mick would like to see Kirsten Wondra replace Charles Huber on this committee. The committee and Fr. would like to see the move toward more of a 'uniform' (come from the same company, X skirt, Y pants, etc.) - this will free up teachers and staff to have to do less judgement to enforce the dress code. Fr. would also like to see a mass day uniform. Mrs. Mattern requested a deadline of the uniform particulars of January 2020 to aid in communication to parents.

Questions on Principal's Report & Financials – A request was posed to see the full Archdiocese Report on Corpus Christi. Mrs. Mattern will be posting the report to Basecamp.

Development/League of Angels – Caleb Regan shared that the Big Bazoohley finished \$3000 above last year's earnings (at \$92,000). With First Fridays bringing in \$4500, the amount left to reach our \$339.5K goal is \$60,100. For the remaining nine months, that sets a rough goal of raising \$6,700 per month.

Financial – The accounting department is in the midst of a personnel change. Bob Washatka is leaving. Deanna Prisinzano will be remotely continuing in her role and Christine Lipscomb will start September 16. Anticipate a report at the next council meeting.

Mrs. Mattern asked for ideas of new people to serve on school council, email her suggestions. We need three council positions - ideally in finance, marketing and development. Preferably, we want to attract to the council the parents of younger students.

The next School Council meeting is scheduled for October 11, 2019.
