Financial – Deanna Prisinzano reported that the December financials have been posted to Basecamp. The 6 month results are right on budget. The income shows short because we have lost some non-parishioner tuition that was unexpected. The expenses are in line with what was projected. Deanna is trying to project financials to the end of June. Tuition income is the most difficult to project.

AdvancEd – Mrs. Mattern reported that the Staff and Parent surveys were completed in the fall of 2018. Mrs. Mattern reported the overall results of the surveys were very high and favorable compared to other schools who are accredited by AdvancED. Student surveys will be given in the beginning of February.

2019-2020 Enrollment – Mrs. Mattern reported that enrollment is currently open to current school families, parish, and community. Enrollment activity so far has been higher than this time last year.

2019-2020 Staff Info – Staff retirements were announced. A search will begin to replace retiring staff members.

School Uniform Policy – Fr. Mick handed out information about school uniforms that he compiled from other sources. Lengthy discussion about revamping the current school uniform policy. The School Uniform committee will revamp the information and report to the Council at the next meeting.
