**2020-2021 Enrollment Information/School Fees/Tuition**

Mrs. Mattern reported that the Middle School Parent Information was not well attended. Mrs. Mattern reported that with the current numbers of 5<sup>th</sup> graders and the possibility of some students going to public school for 6<sup>th</sup> grade, the 6<sup>th</sup> grade class might be as low as 25 next year. If we get no new enrollment for 6<sup>th</sup> grade we may have to just have one class of 6<sup>th</sup> grade next year. This will affect the budget, however, Mrs. Mattern reported that the lower enrollment will not mean a reduction in staff.
